Churches Conservation Trust (CCT) matters for PC Meeting 325

- 1. Dean Wigzell has been appointed the CCT Lead Local Community Officer (South East) since June 2023.
- 2. From January 2024 BCPC clerk to book St Andrew's Church for meetings using the CCT booking form.
- 3. CCT hire charge for PC Meetings = £10 per hour. [BCPC pays £17.50/meeting at Buntingford.]
- 4. CCT has decided that it is no longer necessary to have fire extinguishers in St Andrew's Church. If the community wants to have a fire extinguisher, then they have to organise (and pay for it) themselves.
- 5. On request, following the meeting with Dean Wigzell in November 2023, CCT sent church cleaning guidelines for St Andrew's Church.
- 6. CCT hopes that some more substantial fundraising within the local community can begin the process of contributing towards the upkeep and maintenance of the church.
- 7. BCPC has requested that the blown lightbulbs are replaced and that four more lights are installed near the font, as well as a light onto the altar and the outside light to be fitted with a delay switch.
- 8. CCT confirmed that, subject to due diligence, a local contractor can be engaged to undertake electrical works approved by CCT.
- CCT St Andrew's Church electricity bill for Sept 2023 = £17.71 CCT is currently covering the cost of the electricity bills; the Parish Council is not in a position to support these costs. The CCT is now arranging a new utilities provider.
- 10. The CCT Conservation Team have instructed a Condition Report to be generated for St Andrew's Church in the first half of 2024.
